

Presentation Considerations					
	<u>Cast</u> <u>Distance</u>	Typically refers to a focused on casting long distances.	F 0	<u>Cast</u> <u>Accuracy</u>	Presenting the lure to the precise targeted spot.
F 0	Repetition	Casting repetitively to a high percentage spot.	1 2	Follow-Up Bait	Also called a follow-up lure, are lure ready for a presentation to a specific location typically after a missed hook set.
←	Horizontal Presentations	Lures that transverse through the strike zone parallel to the water surface. Sometimes referred to as a "moving bait".	1	Vertical Presentations	Lures that descend through the strike zone perpendicular to the surface often referred to as jigging.
	Slack-Line Presentations	Slack line introduced in the retrieve.		Tight-Line Presentations	Line to the lure is always taut without the introduction of slack line.
	Rod-Tip Position	Location of the rod tip to maximize lure action, hook set, identify fish on and lure depth.		Lure Action	Lure motion, sound, vibration, flash to entice a bass to bite.
