Skirted Lures with Jig Heads

Common

Flipping Jig
Flipping Jigs are known for their large profile and for targeting heavy grass cover.

Swim Jig
Swim Jigs are known for their natural pulsing swimming motion and their versatility for fishing most cover.

Bladed Jig
Bladed Jigs are known for their pulsing and wobble action produced by its vibrating flashy blade often used when low lure visibility.

Buzzbait
Buzzbaits are known for erratic churning of the water surface creating a bubbly wake, fishable in sparse grass and fished fast to cover water.

Soft Bait Lures with Jig Heads

Common

Ned Rig
Ned Rig Lures are known for light weight, low profile, slow fishing, catch on the fall and for its typically using small vertical worm soft plastic.

Soft Swimbait
Soft Swimbait lures are known for natural looking bait fish lure action and its rigging versatility with a jig head or a single hook.

Shaky Head
Shaky Head Lures known for its subtle, slow moving, low shaky, quiver lure action typically using a worm soft plastic.

Jighead Minnow
Jighead Minnow Lures known for a very subtle natural looking minnow-style and balanced jig head and soft jerkbait plastic combinations.

Less Common

Football Jig
Football Jigs are known for fishing deep and dragging hard bottom, rock and wood cover.

Finesse Jig
Finesse Jigs are known for small light subtle pulse, a slow fall rate and for fishing slow.

Hair Jig
Hair Jigs are known for its unique, more natural, subtle puff and flare and for being fished shallow and deep.

Spinnerbait
Spinnerbaits are known for their blades that spin above the skirt that make a thumping noise and for fishing shallow in low lure visibility.

Less Common

Wobble Head
Wobble Heads are known for their erratic side to side action enabled by a swing hook when targeting hard bottom.

Alabama Rig
Alabama Rigs are known for looking like a small school of baitfish with pulsating and flash lure actions.

Tube
Tube Lures are known for its spiral drop lure action and its tube soft plastic which is often rigged open hooked or weedless (stupid rig).
